Cosmetology is the study of cosmetic treatments to the hair, nails, and skin. Cosmetologists perform an essential role in helping people look and feel their best, and typically work in beauty salons, spas, or barber shops, but also work in more retail locations like department stores, hotels, and cruise ships.

Cosmetologists typically specialize in one of three areas: hair, nails, or skin.

- HAIR STYLIST - trained on proper hair cutting, different design styles, coloring and dying, and braiding.

- NAIL TECHNICIAN - makes sure that their client's finger and toe nails are healthy and beautiful.

- SKIN OR MAKE-UP SPECIALIST - provides treatments to make their client's skin feel smooth, soft, and healthy, while also applying make-up to make their clients look their best.



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
